

Transfer of Duncraig Leisure Centre

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Will Duncraig Leisure Centre (DLC) be renamed by CCSRA?

Yes – Duncraig Leisure Centre will become known as Duncraig Recreation Centre (DRC).

2. When will Duncraig Recreation Centre open after the transfer?

DRC will open under CCSRA management on **Monday 1 February 2021**.

3. What will be the opening hours of Duncraig Recreation Centre?

Monday to Friday: 7.00am – 9.00pm

Saturday: 8.00am – 4.00pm

Sunday: Closed

4. What facilities will be available at Duncraig Recreation Centre?

The following facilities will be available at DRC:

- Sports court (basketball and badminton)
- Fitness classes
- Short courses
- Rooms for hire

5. What facilities do I have access to on a CCSRA membership?

The following facilities are available on a CCSRA membership:

- Group fitness classes at DRC
- Group fitness classes at Warwick Stadium
- Gym at Warwick Stadium
